SCHOOL'S OUT! Happy hols to staff and pupils as half-term break is upon us.

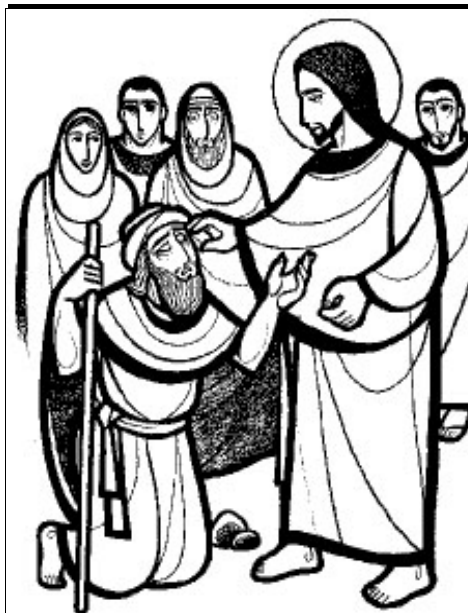
