THIS WEEKEND we celebrate The Baptism of the Lord. At Evening Prayer this Sunday afternoon we come to the end of the Christmas season (although many folk still respect the 40-day season up to February 2nd). For those following the reading in our daily liturgy, "week one in ordinary time" begins on Monday, with weekday readings taken from Year 1 in the three-year sequence. Green is the liturgical colour till Lent begins on 6th March.
