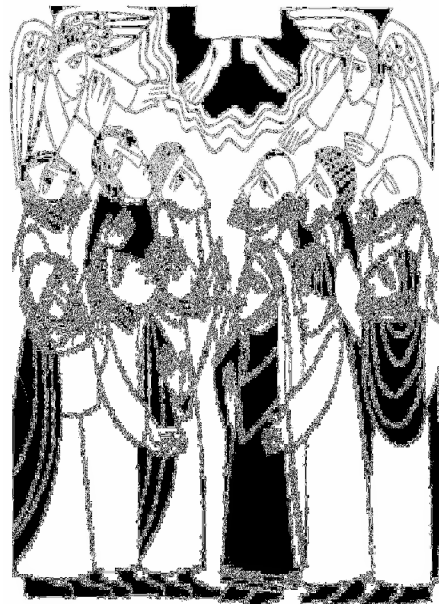
The diocesan website tells more, and posters are at the back of church to suggest ways to help this initiative.
